- Produce a tourist information leaflet about the best places to visit in the USA
- Choose one of the sports athletes from the USA will be competing in and explain how to take part
- Choose one landmark in the USA – create a 3D model, paint a picture, draw a map or make a PowerPoint/video fact-file
- Find out 10 fascinating facts about the country
- Write a story about an athlete from the USA at the Olympics
- On a map, label the route an athlete from the USA would need to travel to reach Paris. Challenge - work out how many kilometres this would be.
- Find out some traditions followed in the USA – present this information in an interesting way
- Design a board game or a quiz all about the USA that you could play with your friends
- Create a fact-file about the wildlife (plants and/or animals)
- Or anything else you can think of to create!
